

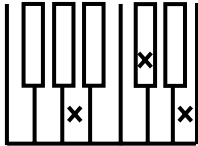
# Major or minor?

## Identifying triads

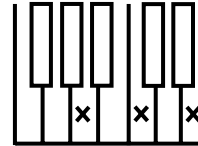
A major chord has a perfect 5<sup>th</sup> and a major 3<sup>rd</sup>.

A minor chord has a perfect 5<sup>th</sup> and a minor 3<sup>rd</sup>.

Perfect 5<sup>th</sup>- 7 half steps  
Major 3<sup>rd</sup>- 4 half steps

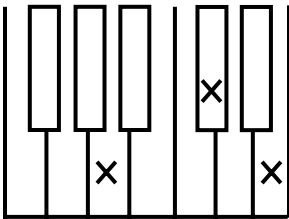


Perfect 5<sup>th</sup>- 7 half steps  
Minor 3<sup>rd</sup>- 3 half steps

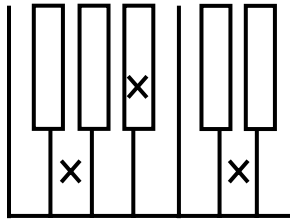


\*When you count half steps, don't forget that you can't count the note you start on! If you count the one you stand on, that would be like standing still and telling someone you took a step!

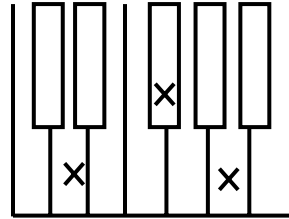
Are these chords major or minor?



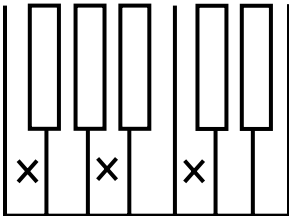
